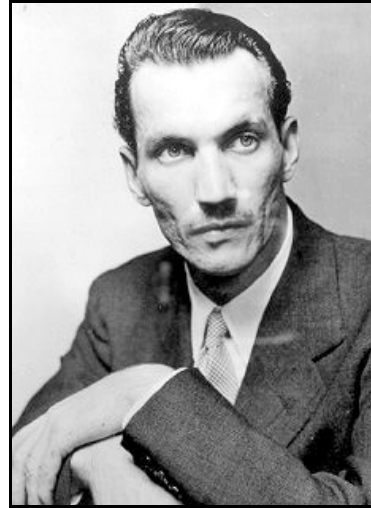


Blue Pumpkin Productions presents
